We talked about:

Kayleigh did a presentation about going to Accident and Emergency (A&E).



Everyone discussed their experiences about going to A&E and what would make it better.



Some people had difficult and scary things happen to them that meant they had to go to A&E.



Some people felt A&E staff and paramedics treated them well, were friendly and explained things clearly.



Other people said that A&E staff did not explain things to them which made them worried and cross.



Most people said that waiting was very hard and confusing.



Things that people said could make A&E better were having a Learning Disability Liaison Nurse working there.



Having good, clear communication about why you are waiting and how long it might be.



Receptionists understanding that communication is harder when you are upset and ill. They should be more patient and talk to people in a way they understand.



Paul and Sammy from Inclusion Gloucestershire told us about their project to help the South West Ambulance service improve.



Paul will send out an Easy Read questionnaire to the network to ask people about using ambulances.


